The intensive 6-day programme will be delivered by specialist pig vet **Dr Annie Davis** of the George Veterinary Group along with a host of expert guest speakers.

Module	Date & Location	Topics
Day 1	5th May Virtual	Introduction, pigs and the Wales Animal Health and Welfare framework, surveillance for disease threats, TB, nutrition, production and performance indicators. <i>This session will be recorded.</i>
Day 2	17th May Glynllifon, Caernarfon	Pregnancy, farrowing, clinical health profiling and planning for positive health (Part 1)
Day 3	18th May Glynllifon, Caernarfon	Pig unit tour (indoor unit), surveillance blood sampling, how to populate a health plan, responsible use of antibiotics <i>Practical</i> – inspection, examination, blood sampling and use of snare; AI (sows permitting)
Day 4	13th July Forest Coal Pit, Abergavenny	<i>Practical</i> – Farm tour (outdoor unit), assessment methods for inspection of pigs, pig husbandry and management, handling, biosecurity, sampling for health profiling
Day 5	7th September WVSC, Aberystwyth	Pig post mortem theory and <i>Practical</i> – post mortem examinations
Day 6	8th September WVSC, Aberystwyth	Pig health planning (Part 2), formulating a bespoke health plan, methods for checking performance vs targets, future innovations.
